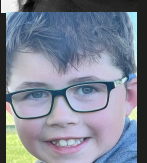
Mercedes Velazquez (Nurse Betty) hopes you enjoy the show!

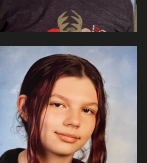

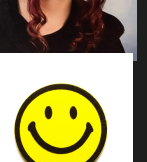

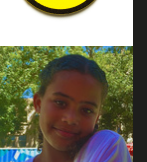
Connor Waite (Cool Kid #1) This is Connor's 2nd musical. He enjoys acting and being a "cool kid!"



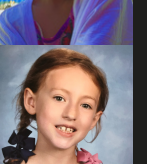
